## DRAFT BY-LAW NUMBER 2021.12 AMENDING REGULATION NO. 150 "ZONING BY-LAW" OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SHIGAWAKE

WHEREAS the amendment to the revised LAND USE PLANNING AND SUSTAINABLE

DEVELOPMENT PLAN OF THE MRC de Bonaventure having the object and consequence of updating the provisions relating to former residual materials landfills that came into force in accordance with the Act dated June 9, 2021.

WHEREAS under the provisions of section 123 of the Act respecting land use planning and

development, the Municipality of Shigawake may amend the content of its zoning by-law to adapt it to the needs expressed by the local community and

deemed relevant by the members of the Municipal Council.

WHEREAS a Notice of Motion of BY-LAW Number 2021.12 was given on December 10<sup>th</sup>

2021;

WHEREAS all members of the municipal council have had in hand the draft By-law number

2021.12

CONSEQUENTLY, it is proposed by councilor Vautier

supported by councilor Gagnon

And it is resolved unanimously by the members present of council that the draft by-law number 2021.12 amending By-law number 150 (Zoning By-law) of the

Municipality of Shigawake be adopted and decree the following:

## Article 1

Section 64 "Provisions Relating to Former Sanitary Landfills, Former Landfills and Former Trench Deposits" of the Zoning By-law (By-law No. 150) of the Municipality of Shigawake is amended by repealing clause 2 which is replaced by the following:

"No new drinking water intake or catchment facility for human consumption may be located within 500 metres of an old trench depot, a former sanitary landfill or a former landfill.

This distance could be less if a scientific (hydrogeological) study shows that the location of a new drinking water intake or new catchment facility for human consumption does not entail any risk of contamination for the population. »

## Article 2

These Regulations will come into force in accordance with the Act.

Adopted at the regular meeting of the Council of the Municipality of Shigawake held on December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at the municipal Hall.
